

SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

OFFICE of the HEAD of SCHOOL

The uniform policy enhances the learning atmosphere, increases a sense of community and reduces competition between students. Tarbiyah Academy students are expected to dress in a way that demonstrates a positive self-image and an attitude of excellence in performance and achievement.

All students are expected to be in full school uniform each day. Neatness, cleanliness, and modesty should be observed at all times. Uniforms should also be worn on school-sponsored field trips unless otherwise specified in a written notification.

Uniforms are to be purchased from our uniform provider, Dennis Uniforms, either online at www.DennisUniform.com or at their retail location (1110C N Rolling Rd, A, Catonsville, MD 21228).

School Uniform Violations

Students are expected to be in proper uniform. If a student is out of uniform or is not in compliance with the below uniform code, the following procedure will be followed:

- **First violation**: uniform notice documented and sent home to be signed and returned the next day.
- **Second violation**: second uniform notice documented and sent home to be signed and returned. A call made home to determine when the proper uniform will be worn.
- **Third violation**: third uniform notice documented and sent home for a signature. Student will not be allowed in classes until a parent/guardian brings in the appropriate uniform item.

School Uniforms can be a wonderful thing for students and parents. They can also be a source of contention when parents and students do not follow school policy. Please help make our school uniform experience a positive one by following the simple policy we've outlined below.

Kindergarten - 2nd Grade

Girls:

- Mondays Thursdays:
 - White short or long sleeved peter pan collared button down shirt WITH school logo from Dennis Uniforms
 - o "Fairmont Plaid-Knife Pleats" Jumper from Dennis Uniforms
 - Black or white leggings, or tights must be worn underneath jumper at all times and may be purchased from Dennis Uniforms or vendor of choice. No pants allowed under the skirts.
 - o Cross over ties are optional on non-formal days
- Formal Fridays & other formal days (announced by school)
 - o Red cross-over ties from Dennis Uniforms **must** be worn with uniform.
- Outerwear:
 - o Sweater Vest: Red V-Neck w/Tarbiyah Academy fiberlok logo
 - o Cardigan: Red Crew Neck w/Tarbiyah Academy fiberlok logo
 - Jacket: There are no restrictions on jackets as long as they are removed inside the school.
 - No hoodies (other than the Tarbiyah Tiger Hoodie on PE Days) or hooded jackets will be allowed in class
- Hijab:
 - Hijab is not mandated by the school uniform. However, if a hijab is chosen, it must be either solid red, solid black, or solid white. No patterns or other colors allowed.
- Shoes:
 - All students must wear flat, soft-soled, closed-toe shoes. No Sandals, Heelys, high heels, hard-soled shoes allowed.

Boys:

- Monday Thursdays:
 - Red short or long sleeved polo style shirt WITH school logo from Dennis Uniforms.
 - o "Irvington Flat Front" khaki pants from Dennis Uniforms.
- Formal Fridays and other formal days (announced by school)
 - White short or long sleeved "Oxford cloth" shirt WITH school logo from Dennis Uniforms
 - o "Fairmont Plaid" tie from Dennis Uniforms **must** be worn with uniform
 - o "Irvington Flat Front" khaki pants from Dennis Uniforms.
- Outerwear:
 - o Pullover: Red V-Neck w/Tarbiyah Academy fiberlok Logo
 - o Sweater Vest: Red V-Neck w/Tarbiyah Academy fiberlok Logo
 - Jacket: There are no restrictions on jackets as long as they are removed inside the school.
 - No hoodies (other than the Tarbiyah Tiger Hoodie on PE Days) or hooded jackets will be allowed in school
- Shoes:
 - All students must wear flat, soft-soled, closed-toe shoes. No Sandals, Heelys, high heels, hard-soled shoes allowed.

3rd – 8th Grade

Girls

- Mondays Thursdays:
 - White short or long sleeved "Taylor" blouse with school logo from Dennis Uniforms
 - o "Fairmont Plaid-Knife Pleats" skirts from Dennis Uniforms
 - Black or white leggings or tights must be worn underneath skirt at all times and may be purchased from Dennis Uniforms or vendor of choice. No pants allowed under the skirts.
 - Optional but highly recommended: Black shorts under skirts purchased from Dennis Uniforms or vendor of choice
 - Cross over ties are optional on non-formal days
- Formal Fridays & other formal days (announced by school)
 - o In addition to the above, red cross-over ties from Dennis Uniforms **must** be worn with uniform. Middle school students must also wear their blazer.

Outerwear:

- o Sweater Vest: Red V-Neck w/Tarbiyah Academy fiberlok logo
- o Cardigan: Red Crew Neck w/Tarbiyah Academy fiberlok logo
- Jacket: There are no restrictions on jackets as long as they are removed inside the school.
- No hoodies (other than the Tarbiyah Tiger Hoodie on PE Days) or hooded jackets will be allowed in school

• Hijab:

 Hijab is not mandated by the school uniform. However, if a hijab is chosen, it must be either solid red, solid black, or solid white. No patterns or other colors allowed.

• Longer Skirts:

• For 5th and 6th grade girls requiring *longer skirts*, custom tailored ankle length skirts are available for purchase from the school.

• Shoes:

 All students must wear flat, soft-soled, closed-toe shoes. No Sandals, Heelys, high heels, hard-soled shoes allowed.

Boys:

- Monday Thursdays:
 - Red short or long sleeved polo style shirt WITH school logo from Dennis Uniforms.
 - o "Irvington Flat Front" khaki pants from Dennis Uniforms.
- Formal Fridays and other formal days (announced by school)
 - White short or long sleeved "Oxford cloth" shirt WITH school logo from Dennis Uniforms
 - o "Fairmont Plaid" tie from Dennis Uniforms **must** be worn with uniform
 - o "Irvington Flat Front" khaki pants from Dennis Uniforms.
 - Middle school students must also wear their blazer.

Outerwear:

- o Pullover: Red V-Neck w/Tarbiyah Academy fiberlok Logo
- o Sweater Vest: Red V-Neck w/Tarbiyah Academy fiberlok Logo
- Jacket: There are no restrictions on jackets as long as they are removed inside the school.

- No hoodies (other than the Tarbiyah Tiger Hoodie on PE Days) or hooded jackets will be allowed in school
- Shoes:
 - All students must wear flat, soft-soled, closed-toe shoes. No Sandals, Heelys, high heels, hard-soled shoes allowed.

PE Uniform

Students are expected to come to school with their PE Uniform on PE days. PE Uniform for both boys and girls are:

- Short or long-sleeved Navy Blue "Tarbiyah Tiger" t-shirt available to order from the school. More info on pre-ordering the PE shirt will be coming soon.
- Black or blue athletic *pants*.
- Athletic sneakers & socks

Prayer Clothes

Tarbiyah Academy students will participate in Dhuhr (noon) prayer on campus. Students are expected to be dressed in appropriate clothing for this purpose as follows:

KG Girls:

• Hijab to cover hair

1st – 8th Grade Girls:

- A one-piece long-sleeved prayer dress that covers until the ankle with attached hijab OR
- Long hijab that covers arms till wrists + prayer skirt that covers until the ankle

Dress Down Non-Uniform Days

At predetermined times, students will be allowed to dress down from their uniform days and dress casually. On those days, students are allowed to wear short sleeved or long sleeved shirts; jeans, or pants. Girls can wear skirts as long as they have shorts and/or tights under them. Students must wear closed toe shoes at all times. No open toed shoes or sandals allowed.

When dressing your child on these days, please be aware and respectful of the diversity in culture, beliefs and backgrounds of the school's environment. Clothing should not have any offensive material. Tarbiyah Academy reserves the right to determine what is appropriate and/or acceptable uniform clothing.
