NATURE CLUB

The Nature Club combines key elements from Qur'an and our Islamic traditions with naturalist courses for children. EXPERIENCING ARCHITECTURE

Students will be led on guided walking tours in the area to experience field sketching and develop observation and analytical skills. We will work on a design of student choice, and produce a complete set of architectural drawings, as well as a physical chipboard or card-stock model. Students will present final designs and models at end of course.
